"||| |||||" is an audiovisual exploration of live coding, circuitbending, and glitch. Its soundscape is composed by a contrasting mixture of 8bit synthesized melodic sounds and distorted analog signals from circuit-bended artefacts, forming two distinct but overlapping layers that also bear deep contrasts in composition, from the digital patterned arrangements that emerge from the computer to the patternless analog signals from the circuitbended artefacts. Its image is generated in real time, consisting of sequences of visual patterns generated by an internal feedback loop that corrupts the original signal, which is directly influenced by the code that is used to generate the sound. Overall, "||| |||||" assumes itself as a piece that explores an abstract landscape with a certain dose of minimalism in sight, in which each performance returns alternate and, sometimes, unexpected outcomes.
